"The expansion extends Beachwood's footprint from their flagship Beachwood in downtown on The Promenade to the Marina, another heavily trafficked section of Long Beach."

The cozy outdoor patio is dog-friendly, has two bar top sections to hang out with your favorite Beachwood bartender and heaters to keep guests warm from the cool evening ocean breeze; seating is first-come, first-served. Six restaurants within 2^{ND} & PCH will be available to order food and have it delivered directly to Beachwood Brewing including Active Culture, The Italian Homemade, Noble Bird Rotisserie, Shake Shack, A PCH and Potato Chips Deli.
